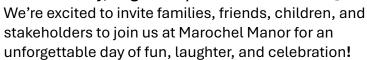

#### **Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) Announcement**

Dear Families, SDMs, and Stakeholders,

I'm pleased to share that we have successfully completed a **second** round of N95 mask fit testing here at Marochel Manor. The majority of our staff have now been properly refitted, ensuring continued compliance with infection prevention protocols and the highest standards of resident safety.

As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining a safe environment, I am actively working toward certification to conduct fit testing onsite. This will allow me to support any remaining staff, as well as volunteers or family members who may wish to be fitted for an N95 mask in the future.

In addition, we are currently reviewing and updating **immunization** records for all employees and volunteers. This includes essential vaccines such as:

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
- **Hepatitis B**
- TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis with a booster recommended every 10 years)

We kindly encourage you, as valued family members and visitors, to review your own immunization status, particularly your adult boosters. Staying protected not only safeguards your own health but also helps us maintain a safe and supportive environment for our residents, many of whom are medically vulnerable.

Thank you for your continued partnership in keeping Marochel Manor a safe and healthy home for everyone.

🌛 🐌 Cucumber Mint Citrus Cooler 🜿 🐚



A Refreshing & Hydrating Drink for Hot Days

### **Ingredients (Serves 6-8):**

- 1 large cucumber, thinly sliced
- 1 lemon, thinly sliced
- 1 lime, thinly sliced
- A handful of fresh mint leaves
- 6 cups cold water
- 1–2 tablespoons honey or agave syrup (optional)
- Ice cubes

#### Instructions:

- 1. In a large pitcher, combine cucumber, lemon, lime, and mint leaves.
- 2. Gently muddle the ingredients with a spoon to release the flavors.
- 3. Add cold water and stir well.
- 4. If using sweetener, dissolve it in a small amount of warm water first, then add to the pitcher.
- 5. Chill in the fridge for at least 1 hour before serving.
- 6. Pour over ice and enjoy!

**Optional:** A splash of sparkling water or club soda

- A few fresh berries or orange slices for color
- Pinch of sea salt (for extra hydration)
